


Take a look into what Azzy had to say as a mod in the server and her journey in handling all the stress that comes from both that role and everyday life.

Does it get difficult balancing your moderating duties with your degree?


"Oh definitely because I wanna help out as much as I can but if I'm trying to focus on my studies it gets really difficult trying to divide the time. I'll do what I can."





Aishu is a member of K-History Club. Let's take a look into what she had to say about the club. Some of her descriptive views are shared below:


So far my favorite topic has been Queen Min and how she served her country! (...) Soora did a great job of explaining the story of Queen Min's death (...)

(...) I kind of like to learn violent types of history; for example, the terror the Imperial Japan imposed on Korea and China during World War II. (...)

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









How are club leadership?

Directions To Sy Chat & Speaking


Chat & Speaking appears to be an activity that is not suitable for beginners. But hold on! That is not the case with Chat & Speaking.

Rather, it is an activity in which you are given a prompt to read and write, depending on your level. So you're a beginner? That's okay! Give this activity a shot if you know how to read basic Hangeul!

Step 1




Wait for the announcement of Chat & Speaking on the bulletinboard channel, which happens every alternate month.



Step 2

Send a modmail using the format mentioned in the announcement.

Step 3

When the time for your Chat & Speaking arrives, an Organizing Staff member will ping you in a Channel under 한국어 ONLY Category.

Step 4

Once you are ready, depending on your level, the staff shall send a prompt in the channel. Don't worry if the prompt feels a little too advanced for you.

According to your level, you will be provided feedback on where you are doing well and where you need to improve.

The first prompt is your Speaking Task. Read the instructions, record yourself reading the prompt and then send it in the channel

- 4. What will Kyeong-eun do if Ju-seok comes to Korea?
- 5. When was the the letter written?

- 1. Where is Gentaro from and what is his major?
- 2. How long has Gentaro been in Korea and how many times has he been there before?

You will receive the feedback via direct messages.

You can cancel the booking up to 6 hours before the scheduled time.






