Why did you choose this club, when there are so many others to choose from?








speaking activity



In February, a month after the server reopened, activities such as the Speaking Activity were resumed. Such activities had been put on pause to give mentors time to prepare material and availability for the sessions.





This month's Run Folk KSG episode was for our birthday boy j-hope.


There were 3 learning activities and 2 fun activities. There were 5 activities in total. To get a server point, 2 of the learning activities were needed.



In the first learning activity that was posted, members got a picture with lyrics from Hobi's songs that had missing words. To complete the activity they had to write the word in Korean and the English translation.



Nae's valentine Event



Once they were able to correctly guess the song, they received a role which allowed them to collect a free item from the shop.









This item gave them access to a command which they could use to collect a one—time amount of 7,777 hearts. Only 7 slots were available and so it was a race once the song had been guessed.


Overall, it was a fun event and Nae hopes to host more like these in the future.


Happy Valentine's everyone!





February saw Nae hosting a second round of the Easter Egg hunt. This time around, the difficulty level was higher. Participants were given an incomplete url which they needed to keep handy. Hidden in messages sent by Nae around the server were letter combinations which would serve as the letters needed to complete the link. Once letters were found, they were to be added to the url and the url then sent in a browser. Should the participant be successful, the url would lead to an image with a lyric from a random Korean song along with the code they needed. The code was then to be sent in the #bot-spam channel where the participant would be awarded the @l found the Easter Egg! role and would be given access to a command which they could use to earn hearts daily. To make it a little more challenging, Nae also put fake combinations in some messages which, when added to the url, would lead to a page that didn't exist. Additionally, participants were given a bonus of 550 hearts if they were able to find the codes for all songs. A total of 5 songs were used this round.







The C&S activity is very helpful got me since I get to have proper review of my skills. It also motivates me to keep upskilling my Korean skills and learning new things and improving myself. Even the manner it is conducted in is very convenient. The passages are also chosen well with many vocabulary to learn from.—Washah K #6441

The C&S activity is a great way to practice your Korean pronunciation and allows you to check your progress over time. It does feel a little daunting at first, but also gives you a sense of achievement when you understand more than you were expecting. I'd certainly recommend trying it out.
