(...) Darcy in particular is very supportive and very good at giving feedback (...)








# J.DI KSG x Euphoria Dance Partnership


In May, & FDI KSG launched its first official partnership with another ARMY organization - Euphoria Dance. This collaboration would bring members of both organizations together to attend online Korean Languages classes hosted by Nae (Qyaadealid). Classes would be focused on learning vocabulary and grammar from various Korean songs, and then working on comprehension skills by translating the lyrics.

The way they give feedback is really nice and understanding. It is really detailed and very helpful. There are things they pick up that I would have never picked up on my own. They give advice as per your level as well. For example, if you know how to read they will talk about your speed. But if they think other areas have to be worked on more, they give you feedback based on that. So they don't give you advice more than what your level is.

I really liked the feedback. It helps me focus more on what I lack and didn't notice with my pronunciation.

The feedback was really helpful! Especially on my speaking, it was specific on what sounds I was troubling with and gave tips on how to correct them.

Anyone who is interested can take part in this activity and can earn one server point by participating in activities mentioned in the event.




For June, RUN KSG was held in celebration of Festa month. Server members took part in various activities that were announced.




Members were required to answer a number of questions on the template provided. Each language level on the server had different requirements, ranging from only needing one word in Korean to everything in Korean.
