






















Could you please give a brief introduction to Anime club for those who have never been in it?


#### Culture Tin Simply saying 안녕하세요 by itself is not quite enough. In Korean culture, a bow normally goes alongside a greeting ith the angle of the bow being dependent on the recipie greeting, i.e. whoever you're saving 'hello' to. ce 안녕하세요 is the standard greeting, that means that ere are others which are used but are not as com

#### Greetings 9년8년니까?

This is simply a more formal and honorific form of 안녕하세요 and is used with people who are guite older than you or those who are in higher positions than you and thus, deserve respect. Thus, you would not use 995(8)-61-1797 to your coworker but you would to the CEO of your company. It is not really common in daily versations, however. It is used in the news and in stores to greet customers

This is the least polite and formal of all the greetings and is only used with peop who you are close to, such as your friends or family, who are the same age as you or younger. It functions just as 안녕하세요 and can be used at all times. Additionally, it can also be used to mean 'goodbye'. This is not the same for '안녕하세요'. There are different words used at that level

The first word we'll learn is a word everyone should be familiar with. This is the word to say 'hello' or to give greetings in Korean. This word is '안녕하세요?'. While there are other variations and ways to greet someone, 29/g8848.2 is the standard greeting. It is used at all times of the day. As opposed to English or other languages, there are no specific ways to say "good morning", "good afternoon", or "good evening". So, whether it is Sam or 8pm, 안생해세요 is the word to use.

안녕하셔요? literally means "Are you at peace?" and comes from the word '안녕하다 which means 'to be at peace'. This then is the reason why the standard response to WMMAR's W
