






In this interview, Vanishared her experience as the owner and admin of the OFD KSG server, and how it has grown over the years.

What about being an admin, could you describe and explain your experience?









































In celebration of the anniversary there was a temporary activity. Across the server, song lyrics were hidden in Nae's messages. Everyone could take part and seek the hidden lyrics. 
Ineak peek of Yearbook. It quick tour around a club that collects memories and moments in the server to bring complete 0+0 KSG Yearbook of the past year.
