# Moonie

Moonie (moonieminnie#0727) has been a member of this server since the beginning. In this interview, we get to ask and learn more about what being a mentor means and how the server has evolved.





Take a look into Moonie's experience as a mentor and the server's evolution since the fetus stage.



**We are here to interview you as a mentor for the yearbook. To start, could you please introduce yourself?**

**Hi, I am Moonie, and I am 24 years old. I have been a mentor since 2020, so from the very beginning.**





**What does a mentor do?**

**(...)We create materials. We don't use our imagination to create things out of the blue, but we search for content. We always check things like if other staff struggle because (...) if they are unsure of what the right answers are, they ask for our help. (...) Now we have staff that goes over it for us, it's a bit easier and takes a lot off our shoulders. (...)**

**(...)What's your favorite material you've made?**

**(...)Also, the numbers, the big numbers. It was so confusing but when you got them right, it was very fulfilling. (...)**





**And how do you find your experience?**

**It has been fun. It was a lot of hard work in the beginning, as I said before. Because we didn't know what we were doing (...) I always try to help but sometimes I can't. But it's fun, it's fun. I like helping people and sharing what I know. Even if I don't know, I search it up for hours to make sure I'm right before I say something. So yeah, it's fun.**





**(...)What advice would you give to anyone wanting to apply to be a mentor?**

**(...) Don't be afraid to do it. If you think you're not capable of answering stuff because you are not sure you can always ask us, no need to be afraid. (...)We're also learning, we also don't know some stuff, so we search for it and we make sure we're always on the same page. So come talk with us, join the cult \*laughs\***

## The tradition behind the half-moon shape...

The half-moon shape is rooted in tradition, stemming from a Korean legend from the Three Kingdoms era (57 BC-668 AD) about the rival kingdoms, Baekje and Silla. It says that during the reign of King Uija of Baekje, he found a turtle with odd markings on its back which were read by his advisors as meaning "Baekje full moon, Silla half-moon". They interpreted this to mean that the Baekje kingdom would fall and the Silla dynasty would rise - a prophecy which was fulfilled when Silla defeated Baekje later on. Ever since, the half-moon shape has been taken as an indicator of victory or a bright future by Koreans, which is why songpyeon are often made in this shape.

### The Case of the Frog Boys

This case is really upsetting, from the initial children going missing to only finding the remains of the boys 11 years later, so close to their homes. Upon reading [this](#) and [this](#) blog, I have a theory that the children were murdered by the military.

Fast forwarding to the searches after the Frog Boys were found missing, I always questioned why 노태우 (Roh Tae-woo), the president at the time, was so heavily involved in the search for the boys. Not to say he wasn't allowed to be concerned, but kids go missing often, why was this case so important that he had to get involved?

So I got curious and looked up 노태우's background, 노태우 was previously a soldier in the Korean War and was promoted up the ranks to Sergeant Cannoneer and later on was a Military General who helped 전두환 (Chun Doo-hwan) gain military dictatorship in the Gwangju Massacre. To summarize the Gwangju Massacre, armed citizens were fighting back against their (at the time) authoritarian government, just to have it taken over by another dictator during the event. 전두환 was that dictator and 노태우 helped make it happen.

It's safe to say that 노태우 is very involved with the military and would do anything to protect it. He has plenty of reasons to protect the military base and his men as much as possible.

Looking at the damages the boys' bodies suffered, two bullet holes in one boy and harsh blunt hits on the rest of the boys, this damage was made from someone who was

## NO ONE WAS ABLE TO SOLVE THE CASE OF THE FIVE MISSING CHILDREN. ISN'T THAT SHAMEFUL? "FROG BOYS"

On March 26, 1991, five young boys set off for a day of fun together, catching frogs in the streams of Mount Waryong. South Korea as their country celebrated a public holiday. But by the time the sun set, U Cheol-won, 13, Jo Ho-yeon, 12, Kim Yeong-gyu, 11, Park Chan-in, 10, and Kim Jong-sik, nine, had failed to return home.

Worried, their parents began searching for them. But after hours of looking, they found no trace and reported the missing boys to the police.

According to the Korea JoongAng Daily, South Korea's president at the time, President Roh Tae-woo undertook a massive search, dispatching a police force of 300,000 and operating a special investigation centre to look for the boys. They searched reservoirs, irrigation waterways, bus terminals and stations nationwide.

Schools, companies and civic groups made donations totalling 42 million won (\$35,000) as a reward to those who found the boys, the publication reported.

But none of these efforts were successful and the boys remained missing. There seemed to be no clues. Rumours abounded about the disappearance. Some speculated that they had been kidnapped by a "mentally ill person", as reported by Korea JoongAng Daily.

On September 26, 2002, 11 years after their disappearance, all five of the boys' bodies were discovered by two men on Mount Waryong, only two kilometres from their homes.

Initially, the police said that they had found no indications of homicide and that the most likely explanation is that the children froze to death.

According to Korea JoongAng Daily, the bodies were entwined, suggesting they'd tried to overcome the cold by huddling together.

But after the forensic medicine team from Kyungpook National University examined the bodies, they determined that their deaths were the result of foul play.



# HOW WE MAKE COVERS

**Dance Club's main task is to learn choreography. Sol and I learn the choreography since she is the one who takes over when I can not host a meeting. (...)**



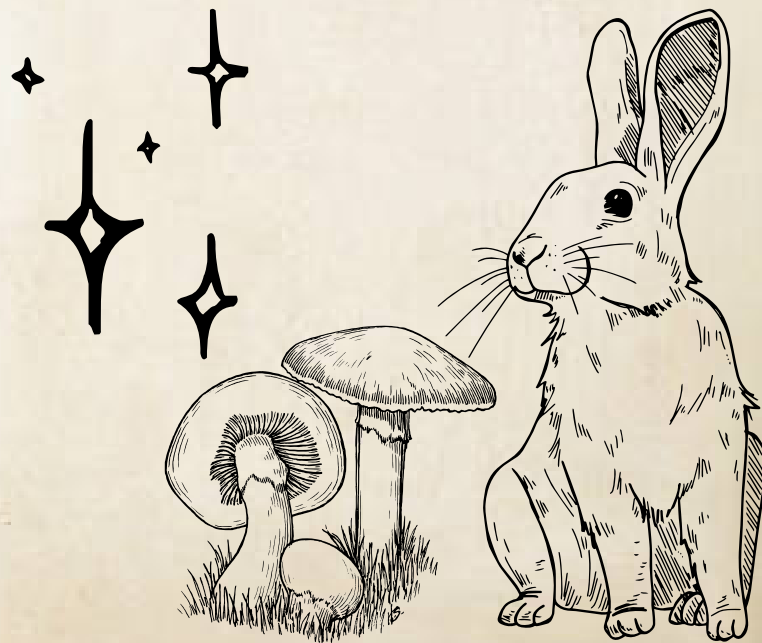

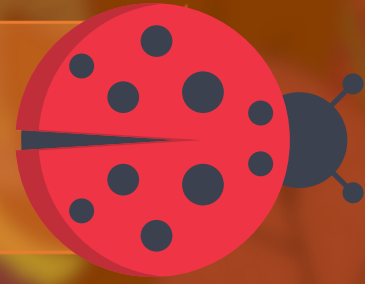

**Definitely! If they are like me and are just looking for an excuse to dance, it's definitely worth going for it! (...)**



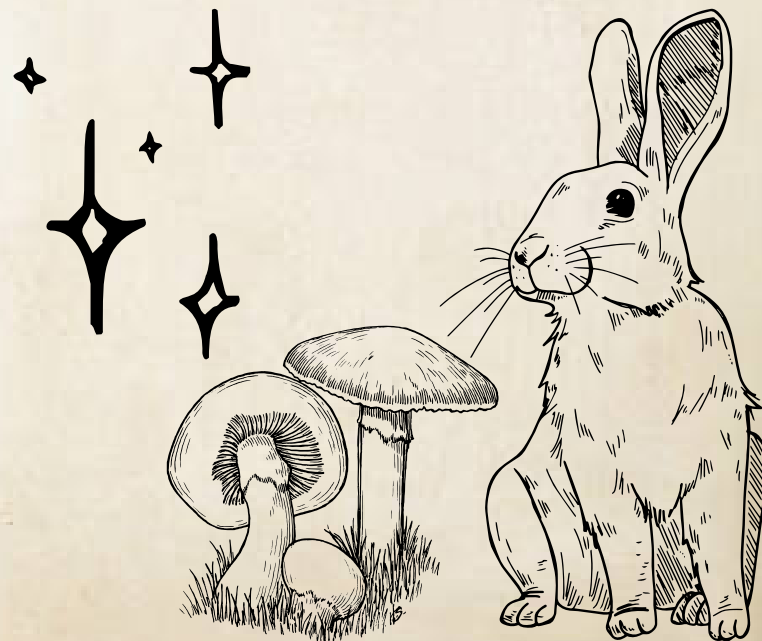

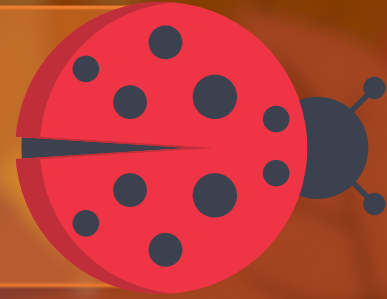

If the members don't show up in the scheduled time, they get warned but if they do inform organizer staff 6 hours prior to their scheduled time then they won't get a warning.**





**Chat and Speaking is one of the activities available on the server. Previously it was the activity for soundcheck members and was held every month but later when the server turned to general members only, it started being held every other month.**

**Everyone can do this activity and they also get 1 server point from it. The announcement for C&S activity is put up in bulletinboard channel every other month and members can start scheduling for their available dates as per the given prompt through modmails. Members can check the sheet given in the announcement to see the available timings and schedule accordingly. Members from the same level role group can't schedule for the same time therefore they should check the sheet and make sure that the times are not clashing. If the members don't show up in the scheduled time, they get warned but if they do inform organizer staff 6 hours prior to their scheduled time then they won't get a warning.**







**Mentors prepare different questions for the members as per their level role. The level roles are divided in 3 groups i.e (i)Begin and Does it make sense, (ii)Does it make sense, Am I Wrong and 2nd grade, (iii) 2,3 and I'm Fine. If the member has Does it make sense but can't form sentences then they are given questions same as for begin but if they do know how to form sentences then they are given a different set of questions. Once members schedule the time they are added to different channels about 5 or 10 minutes ahead of their scheduled time as per their level role and they are given the prompt. They only need about 35 minutes to finish the activity. As per the prompt given, for writing they are asked to answer questions by reading the paragraph or they might have to translate the paragraph or different questions relating to writing are given. Similarly for the Speaking part, they would have to record themselves reading the given paragraph and send the file in the channel. Fixed time is given for both writing and speaking. The c&s session is held by one of the organiser staff, so there will only be the said member who is doing the activity and the staff who is conducting the activity in the channel at that time. Organiser staff will be there to guide them and keep track of time but they won't check the answers. Later mentors check their answers and personally message them to give feedback.**

#### Importance

There's a comfort to the rain and gloomy weather. It almost feels like you don't have to hide how sad you are. Even if there's another part of your life or version of yourself that perhaps others could perceive as being lucky or undeserving of being sad. Although Joon says that he doesn't know his end, he knows that if the person he loves exists, then they would be his end. It could also mean that this person makes him complete, as he is his own beginning and the entrance of love completes the circle.

To be a person's gentle wave is from Joon's fan cafe post in which he wishes to be someone who gives a gentle impact in the tempest that is life. Calling his lover the sea could be a way to describe the overwhelming feeling he gets from them. He wants to know how he can make an impact in their life when they already have thousands of waves crashing and tumbling in their life.

The last verses paint a picture of intimacy where Joon says he is speaking the same language as them, the language being love. To breathe their breath means to live and exist right beside them or to live in their life as well; two bodies but one soul. This is then solidified by saying he will become them by holding them close in his life. He is not just talking about his love or his life in these verses, instead, he is talking about being the best of himself by giving himself completely to his lover.

The last line is my personal favorite where he says 'I kiss your sword' which is an oath one takes to prove or show loyalty. A sword is a weapon of destruction and it is also a symbol of strength and power. To tell them that he will love their strength as well as their darkness

"One says 'run' another says 'stop'" is easily interpreted as two opposite instructions. "This one says 'look at the forest' that one says 'look at the wild flower'" is a reference to two South Korean proverbs. "Look at the forest" is an admonition to step back and look at the big picture; "Look at the wild flower" is an admonition to find value in the small things of life.
