We are here to interview you as a mentor for the yearbook. To start, could you please introduce yourself?

Hi, I am Moonie, and I am 24 years old. I have been a mentor since 2020, so from the very beginning.





What does a mentor do?

(...)We create materials. We don't use our imagination to create things out of the blue, but we search for content. We always check things like if other staff struggle because (...) if they are unsure of what the right answers are, they ask for our help. (...) Now we have staff that goes over it for us, it's a bit easier and takes a lot off our shoulders. (...)

(...)What's your favorite material you've made?

(...)Also, the numbers, the big numbers. It was so confusing but when you got them right, it was very fulfilling. (...)

And how do you find your experience?

It has been fun. It was a lot of hard work in the beginning, as I said before. Because we didn't know what we were doing (...) I always try to help but sometimes I can't. But it's fun, it's fun. I like helping people and sharing what I know. Even if I don't know, I search it up for hours to make sure I'm right before I say something. So yeah, it's fun.



(...)What advice would you give to anyone wanting to apply to be a mentor?

(...) Don't be afraid to do it. If you think you're not capable of answering stuff because you are not sure you can always ask us, no need to be afraid. (...)We're also learning, we also don't know some stuff, so we search for it and we make sure we're always on the same page. So come talk with us, join the cult *laughs*

Don't think. Unless you aren't at a solid level in Korean, don't be afraid to apply(...)

(...)We have discussions among ourselves sometimes to say "hey is this correct because I don't know", sometimes there is a word or grammar point that we aren't familiar with so it's okay(...)

One thing that has been on my mind is to have an intermediate course(...)

(...)So basically I just worked until my mind was like "okay this is where we stop" and we stopped and then we regained a little strength and we were back at it again(...) It got me to finish in time and it wasn't where I was trying to complete everything all at once, so it wasn't too overwhelming.

The Case of the Frog Boys

How long does it take you to learn a dance?



What are the interesting things you've learnt in the club and name something you have gained?



Definitely! If they are like me and are just looking for an excuse to dance, it's definitely worth going for it! (...)



"Look at the forest" is an admonition to step back and look at the big picture; "Look at the wild flower" is an admonition to find value in the small things of life.

Namioon acknowledges his dark side, he named it "hesitation".
